Entrance time for *King Tut* will be 12:30 pm with a recommended line-up time at noon. We have been advised that the exhibition will take several hours to explore. A 3:00 or 3:30 pm departure for a dinner stop in Chinatown and return to Fresno at approximately 10:00 pm.

This new exhibition celebrates the 100-year anniversary of the discovery of King Tut's tomb in 1918. It is the largest King Tut exhibition to ever tour and includes over 150 artifacts, many of which were used by the boy king in both life and after death. Sixty of the items in the exhibition make their debut outside of Egypt.

Included is a dramatic new multimedia presentation that complements the exhibition and takes you on an immersive journey of the pharaoh's quest for immortality. Follow the boy king as he travels from the underworld through the twelve gates and to the afterlife.

Discover how the scientific analysis of King Tut's 3,300-year-old mummy has revealed new information about his health and lineage, as well as how cutting-edge technologies have played a role in discovering new tombs and analyzing existing ones in ways never before imagined.
